Guided Tours

Docents are available to guide groups on a structured visit providing highlights from the many collections. Guided tours may be scheduled for one hour and are available for up to 50 people. Please arrive 10 to 15 minutes in advance. Groups arriving later than 20 minutes may forfeit their guided tour but are welcome to enjoy the museum on a self-guided visit.

Self-Guided Tours

Self-guided Tours allow groups to enjoy the museum at their leisure with docents available to answer questions. At least one hour is recommended.

Group Rates Per Person (group rates apply to parties of 10 or more who have reserved in advance)

\$5 - Adults

\$4 - Seniors & Students

\$3 - Children (up to age 12)*

*Guided Tour - 1 chaperone per 10 children is free and required

*Self-Guided Tour - 1 chaperone per 5 children is free and required

Note: The regular free admission discount for children under 5 does not apply to group tours.

Payment

- Payment is due in full on the day of the visit.
- Please have 1 person pay for the group (this will eliminate any unnecessary delays) by cash, check or credit card (Visa & MasterCard are accepted).
- Coupons or discounts may not be used in conjunction with the group rate.
- Rates are subject to change without notice.

Museum Guidelines

Groups unable to comply with the guidelines will be asked to leave the museum. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

- Chaperones are required to stay with their groups at all times and are responsible for the conduct of their children or students. Please remind your children or students to be respectful of other visitors as they tour the museum.
- The Toy & Miniature Museum is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is permitted outside near trash receptacles fitted with ash trays.
- Food, drink, candy and chewing gum may not be consumed inside the museum.
- Photography and video recordings are not permitted inside the museum.
- Due to the limited size of the Museum Store no more than 10 children or students are allowed in the Gift Shop at one time.
- An unattended coat room is available inside the facility. The museum is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
- No pets except service animals are permitted inside the museum.
- Cell phone use is restricted to the center hall of the museum to ensure the enjoyment of all museum patrons.
- Enjoy the collections with your eyes & mind, but please do not touch.
