Be one of the first to view and purchase work made exclusively for Miniature Masterworks. Miniature Masterworks Preview and Sale tickets include the preview, and admission to the museum on Friday, September 15, and Miniature Masterworks on Saturday, September 16, and Sunday, September 17.

Tickets are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are limited to 4 tickets per person. Packets can be picked up from 10AM-3:30PM on Friday, September 15 at T/m. Tickets holders may arrive at 5:30PM to collect their packets and find their place in line. Line placement is based on the level of ticket purchased. Presented in partnership with the International Guild of Miniature Artisans, Miniature Masterworks is a three-day event at The National Museum of Toys and Miniatures featuring fine-scale miniature artists showcasing and selling their work. Attendees will be able to tour the museum's collection of fine-scale miniatures, meet the artists, attend gallery talks and programs, and view the works presented with the Barbara Marshall Award for Artistic Achievement.

Miniature Masterworks is included with museum admission. Admission can be purchased at the museum the day of the event. Admission is \$5 for ages 5 and up, free for ages 4 and under, museum members, UMKC faculty, staff, and students, and active duty military and their families.
